

**Lake City teens injured in one-car crash**

A pair of 17 year old Lake City girls were critically injured in a Tuesday evening, one-car crash in Columbia County.

According to the Florida Highway Patrol, the driver of the 1993 Ford Escort station wagon was Ronesia A. Edwards and her only passenger was Kayla D. Reynolds.

FHP Trooper J. R. Taylor said the 6:38 p.m. crash happened on Southwest Brim Street about 4.5 miles west of Lake City.

In his report on the crash, Taylor wrote that the Escort was headed west on Brim St. when Edwards lost control of the car. The Escort left the roadway, went through a fence and hit a tree.

Edwards and Reynolds were flown to Shands at the University of Florida with critical injuries.

Taylor's report also noted that Edwards had not been wearing her seat belt, that alcohol was not a factor and that charges in the crash were pending further investigation.
